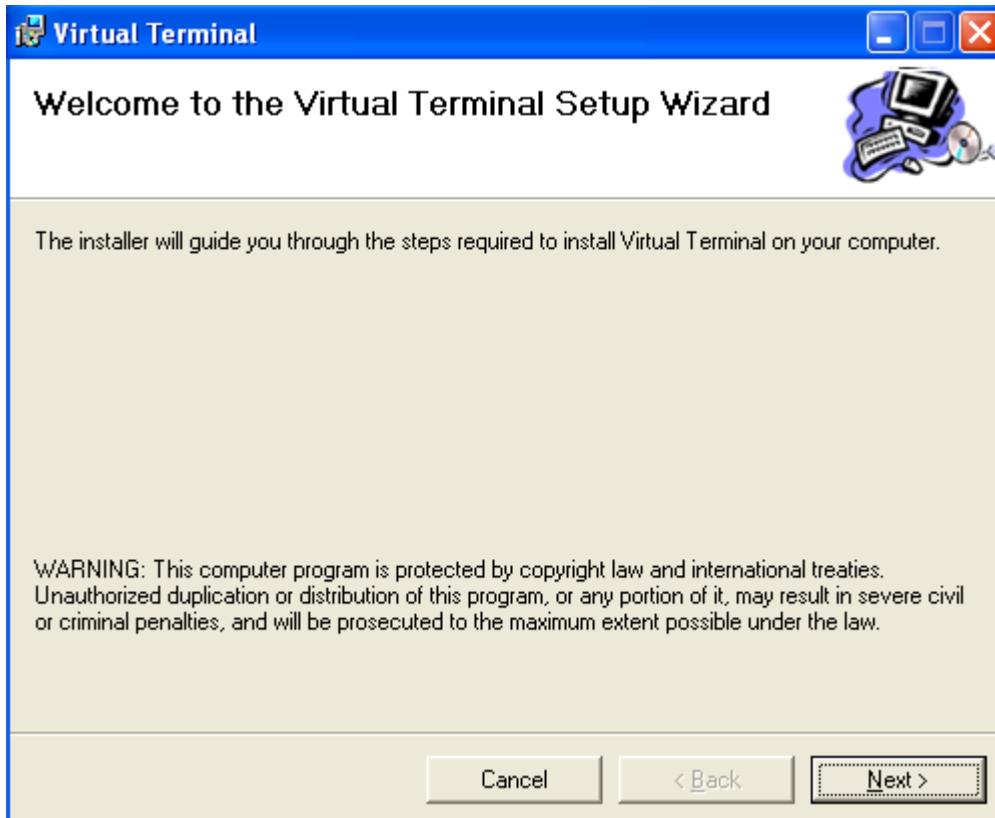
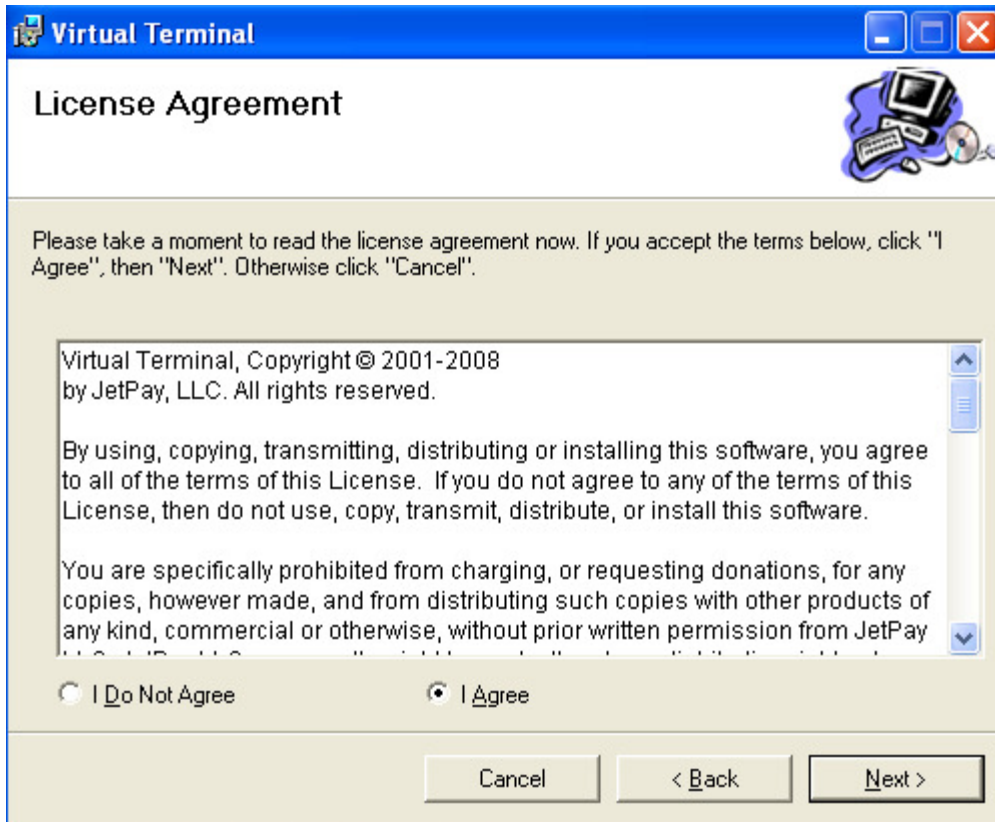


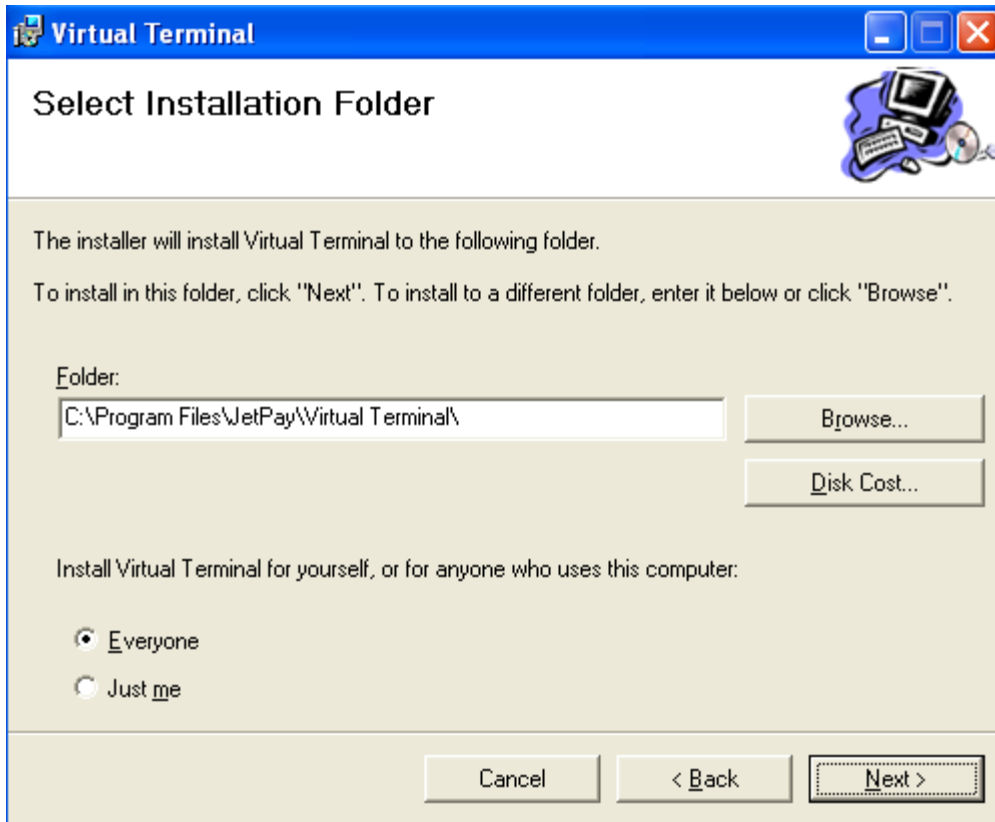
## INSTALLING VIRTUAL TERMINAL



This is the first screen you will see after you double click the setup.exe file to install Virtual Terminal. Click "Next" to proceed.



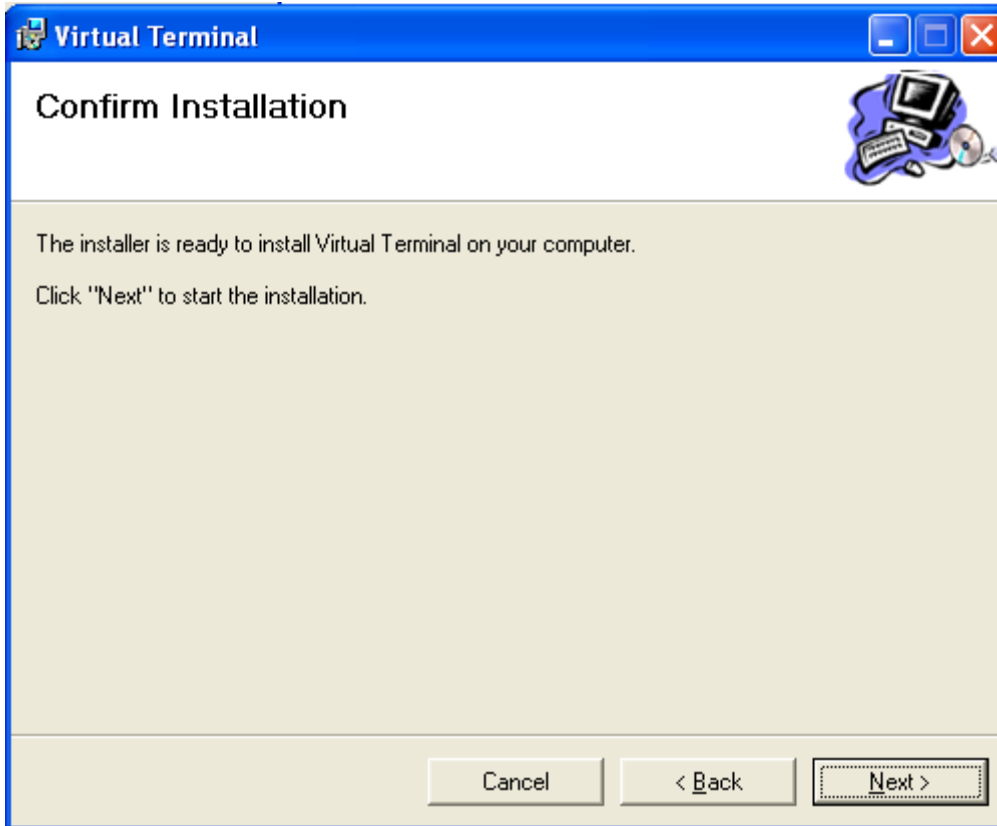
Read the License Agreement and make sure the radio button has selected "I Agree" before clicking "Next" button to proceed.



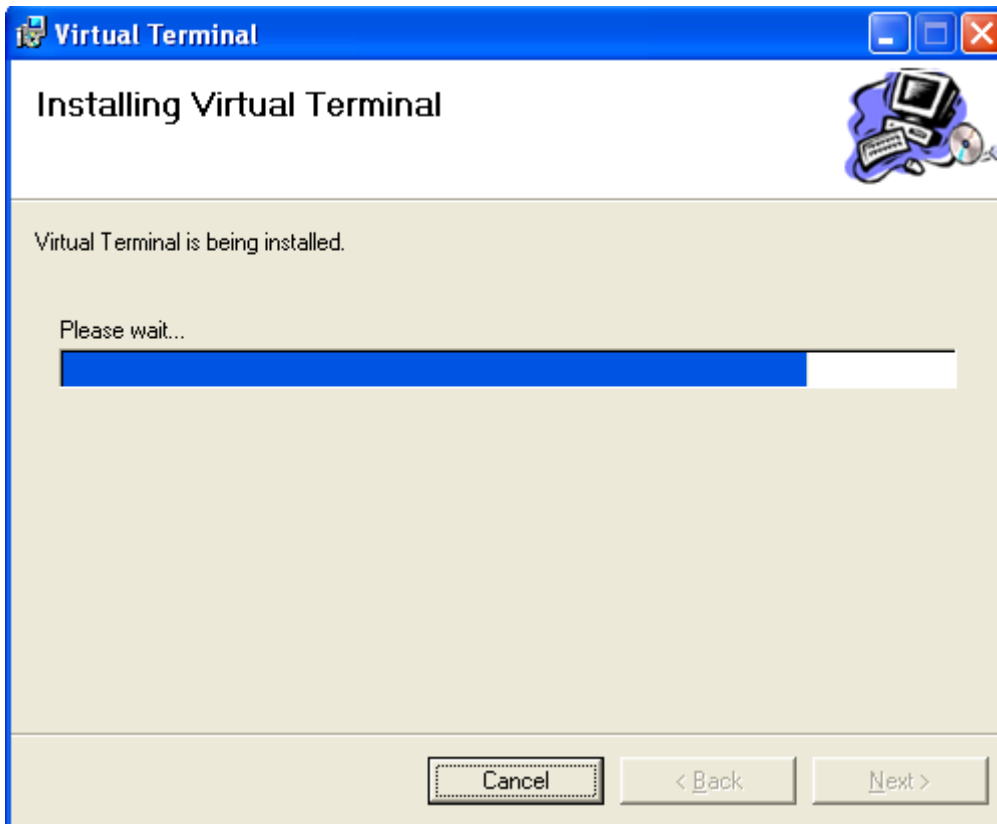
If you want to install Virtual Terminal to another location then click Browse and point the installer to where you want the program to install to. We recommend you leave it set to the default path given above.

As for the second question, we recommend leaving this set to “Everyone” so that if another person logs on to that machine they will be able to use Virtual Terminal without having to install it again under their Windows profile.

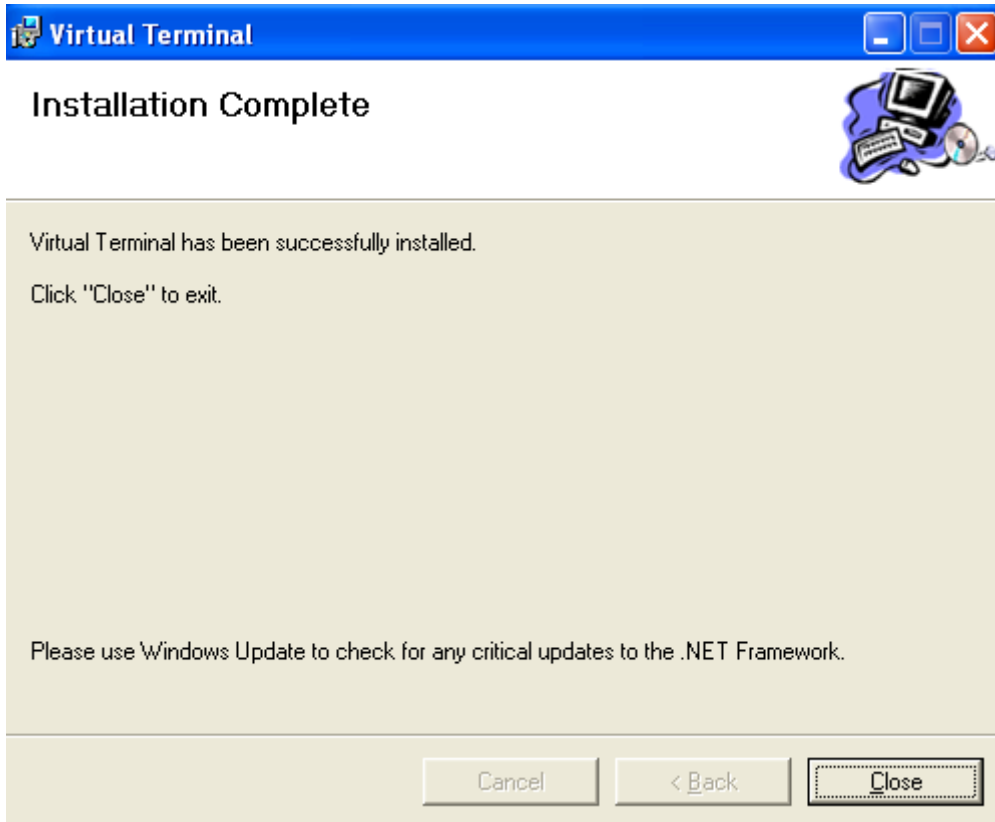
Click “Next” button to proceed.



Hit the “Next” button again to begin the actual installation of files for Virtual Terminal.



You will see a blue bar indicating the progress of the install. It may complete and start over several times-do not be alarmed- it is working as designed.



When the install is completed you will see the screen above. Click "Close" to complete the installation wizard.
